Theater Jazz at Sevier Park

CLASS PRE-REQUISITES

No experience necessary for Creative Tap, Tap Basics , or Beginning Theater Jazz for the fall session. For higher levels, students must have completed at least one full year of the previous level (or equivalent) before advancing. Placement for current students is determined by instructor recommendation.

NEW / TRANSFER STUDENTS

New students beyond the beginning levels or transfer students hoping to join the Winter/Spring session must email the Dance Division Supervisor at kathryn.wilkening@nashville.gov to schedule a placement class.

AGE REQUIREMENTS

Students must be the minimum age by August 15, 2021 for both the Fall 2021 and Winter/Spring 2022 Sessions. This age requirement aligns with the MNPS age requirement for the school year.
